PROPOSED 2021-2022 REESTABLISHMENT PLAN FOR MAGISTERIAL DISTRICTS

The Sixth Judicial District of Pennsylvania is comprised of the Court of Common Pleas and thirteen Magisterial District Courts. Pursuant to 42 Pa. C. S. Section 1503, courts are required to reestablish magisterial districts every ten years. This occurs in each year following the federal decennial census. The Court must reestablish the number and jurisdictional boundaries of the magisterial districts within the judicial district.

By directive of the Pennsylvania Supreme Court, we began the process by conferring with each Magisterial District Judge in the County. After a review of the relevant data provided by the Administrative Office of Pennsylvania Courts (AOPC) and suggestions of Erie County's Magisterial District Judges, each magisterial district within Erie County was evaluated. Among factors considered were: population, caseload and workload measures. As a result, the following plan is being considered for submission to the Pennsylvania Supreme Court by President Judge Joseph M. Walsh, III:

All districts will remain unchanged.

This proposed plan serves the needs of the citizens of Erie County and meets the needs of the Courts. A key part of the reestablishment process is the solicitation of public comment. In order to facilitate that process, any citizen who wishes to comment may view the attached relevant statistical data, or view it at the office of Robert J.
