Re: Re-establishment Proposal for the 31<sup>st</sup> Judicial District (Lehigh County)

Dear Mr. Mittleman:

This letter with attachments is submitted pursuant to the request for re-establishment of Magisterial District Court ("District Court") boundaries as is statutorily required as a result of the 2020 census.

According to Pennsylvania Supreme Court and AOPC instructions, the primary goal of this plan is to achieve workload equity among the District Courts within the 31<sup>st</sup> Judicial District (Lehigh County) while considering and planning for foreseeable future changes to the existing structure of Lehigh County as it may impact case filings and workload.

The primary considerations in developing this plan include existing average caseloads per District Court, crime statistics within the City of Allentown, population according to the 2020 Census, revitalization projects planned within the City of Allentown, and the increased enforcement activities by the Allentown Parking Authority.

Currently, the City of Allentown is in the midst of an on-going revitalization project. In the last two years, three (3) apartment buildings comprising 268 residential units with street level retail space were added within the boundaries of District Court 31-2-01. In the next two (2) years, two (2) additional apartment buildings comprising 300+ residential units will be built within the boundaries of this District. Within the boundaries of District Court 31-1-03, two (2) apartment buildings comprising 286 residential units with street level retail space were built. Two (2) more residential apartments are planned for this District adding 196 more residential units. In addition, the close of 2022 will bring a 16-floor (296,000 square feet) office building

with street level retail space. Lastly, a 170-unit residential apartment building is planned within the boundaries of District Court 31-1-04.

Beyond the revitalization projects planned in Allentown's Center City, a Waterfront Project is planned for Wards 1 and 6, which includes a new highway connecting the waterfront area to Route 22. The waterfront is expected to be developed with hotels, retail space, office space, residential apartments, restaurants, and recreational trails along the Lehigh River.

Overall, Lehigh County has seen an 8% population increase since 2010, and average case filings decreased by 11% since 2014. Twenty-seven percent (27%) of the population of this increase is within the City of Allentown. While the population was increasing countywide between 2014–2019, case filings were decreasing. Lehigh County had a 9% decrease in case filings during this time. While the District Courts surrounding Allentown maintained a lower caseload in 2021, with an additional 18% drop in filings, Allentown's case filings increased by 40% in 2021. This is a result of the increased enforcement efforts by the Allentown Parking Authority. In the last five (5) years, filings for parking violations increased 64% in the District Courts within the City of Allentown. This increased parking enforcement is expected to continue in the long term.

In consideration of the revitalization plans, inner city population increases, and increased parking enforcement, Lehigh County will be better served with opening an additional District Court within the City of Allentown. In order to achieve workload equity, we propose to eliminate District Court 31-2-03 and open a new District Court to serve Allentown City Wards 6 and 10.

The average workload for District Court 31-2-03 is 38% below the average for Lehigh County. We propose that, upon elimination of this District Court, the boundaries for District Court 31-3-03 be redrawn to include Emmaus and Macungie Boroughs. (Lower Macungie would move to DC 31-3-02.) The workload for District Court 31-3-03 is 51% below the average workload for Lehigh County. Combining these District Courts would result in a District Court with an average workload within 15% of the average for Lehigh County.

The average workload for District Court 31-1-01 is 33% above the average for Lehigh County. With the influx of new filings for parking violations, the workload average is 45% higher than the Lehigh County average. The average case filings are 75% higher than the average for a 3<sup>rd</sup> Class County. The average workload for District Court 31-2-01 is 26% above the average for Lehigh County. With the influx of new filings for parking violations, the workload average is 37% above the workload average for Lehigh County. Realigning the 6<sup>th</sup> Ward from District Court 31-2-01 and the 10<sup>th</sup> Ward from District Court 31-1-01 to create a new District Court will assist in achieving workload equity for District Court 31-1-01, District Court 31-2-01, and the proposed new District Court.

In the interest of public convenience, we recommend that the boundaries of District Court 31-1-04 be re-aligned to move Allentown's 2<sup>nd</sup> Ward to District Court 31-2-01. The workload impact to either of these District Courts is minimal. However, the impact on the public doing business in person with the District Court will be significantly improved. The 2<sup>nd</sup> Ward is within walking distance to District Court 31-2-01 while District Court 31-1-04 is a 2.5 mile commute.

Lehigh County's "Annual Average Filings per Court" is 16% higher than the average for a Class 3 County, which is the highest per-court caseload in comparison to other Class 3 Counties. Implementing the proposed plan will bring Lehigh County closer to achieving countywide workload equity.



#### 20. Additional Comments:

The average case filings reported per case filings provided by AOPC are based on filings from 2014 - 2020. This does not accurately reflect current case filings for this office. In 2020, the Allentown parking authority significantly increased staffing of enforcement officers and the hours of enforcement. In 2021 case filings for this office totaled 18,453 and increased the workload to 87,219, which is 45% over the average workload for the judicial district. It is reported that this trend will continue.

Per local crime statics, 30% of all criminal activity in Allentown occurs in Wards 8 & 10. (Ward 8=13% and Ward 10=17%)

The MDJ lives in the Ward from which the bulk of filings are generated. The District Court location is at the opposite end of the District. Moving any of the remaining wards would result in noncontiguous boundaries. Additionally, moving any of the remaining wards currently existing within this district to a surrounding district would increase the surrounding workload above the 15% threshold. Note that 50% of Court Criminal cases filed in this District are held in Central Court.
