

## **Magisterial District Reestablishment Proposal Public Comment Posting**

**LEWISTOWN, PA** – The reestablishment plan for Mifflin County's three magisterial district courts is on display for a period of 30 days. The plan is accessible from the Mifflin County Government homepage ([www.co.mifflin.pa.us](http://www.co.mifflin.pa.us)) by following the links to the Court Office or Magisterial District Judges. This plan will also be posted within each MDJ court and within the Mifflin County Commissioners' Office. Boundary changes are proposed for 58-3-01 (MD Judge Miller) and 58-3-03 (MD Judge Smith). No boundary changes are anticipated for 58-3-02 (MD Judge Reed).

The time for public comment will expire at the close of business Wednesday, November 24, 2021. The proposed realignment would take the current workload for this court from 14,846 to 19,246, which takes it from a 33% below average workload to a 14% below average workload. There would be a more equitable distribution of case filings and workload among all our minor courts within this judicial district.
